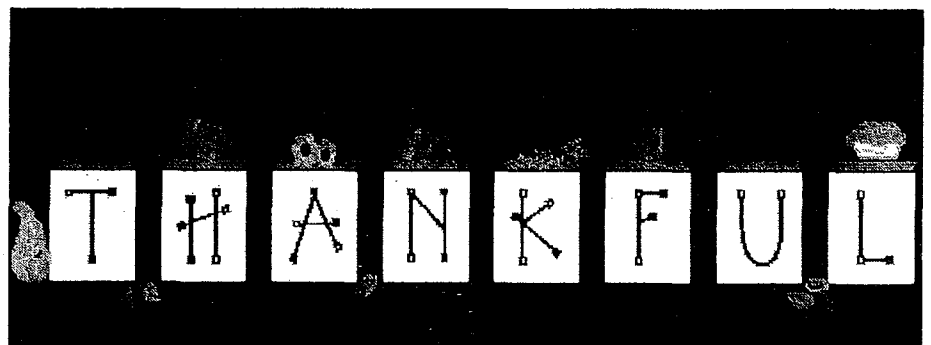


Things to Remember
